

English

We will be looking at texts that explore the theme of "Coast" and "Hot and cold places". Some of these include *Blown away* and *Duffly's Lucky escape*. We will be writing finding stories, a non-chronological report, and a thematic poem.

Maths

We will cover a variety of units this term, including multiplication, division, halves and quarters, position and direction, numbers to 100, time and money. We will continue to use the app numbots to develop our fluency.

Science

In Science we will learn to observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. They will look at different seeds and plants to establish their similarities and differences.

Coast



Music

In Music we will be learning to accompany rhymes or songs with a pulse. We will be looking at the composer Mozart.

Physical Education

In PE this term, we will be focusing on the concept of Athletics. We will be exploring a number of different activities to enable all children to access Sports Day.

Hot and cold places

In DT this term, we will be exploring mechanisms where they will be looking at sliders and levers to create a moving poster.

Religious Education

In Summer 1 we will look at Judaism. They will explore 'Is shabbat important to Jewish people?' In Summer 2 we will continue to explore Judaism. We will explore the enquiry question 'Does Chanukah make Jewish children feel closer to God?'

Geography

In Geography we are learning about the coast and hot and cold countries. They will develop their understanding of locality, space, and scale through exploring local environments using maps and images.

Computing

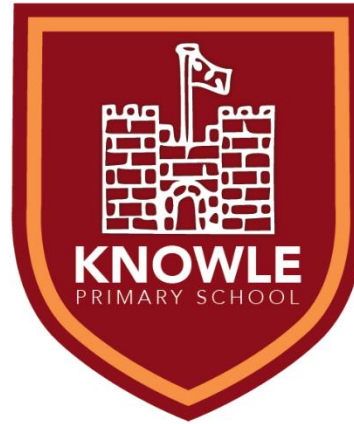
In Computing we will learn basic painting skills in an application on an iPad. They will use a simple painting program to paint with different colours, brushes, create shapes, fill areas, and add text.
