

### English

In English we will be exploring the story of The Three Wishes. The children will then attempt to write their own. We will also be looking at South Africa and persuading people to visit. We will be linking this to pollution and exploring how pollution has an impact on our planet.

### Maths

In Year 2 Maths lessons, we will be learning about multiplication and division and moving on to explore length and height. We will also be completing daily number master sessions, accessing Numbots and continuing to improve our times tables using TTRS.

### Science

In Science we will have a specific focus on common, wild and garden plants including deciduous and evergreen trees. We will also be looking at the changes across the 4 seasons and the weather.

# Plymouth & South Africa

### Physical Education

In PE this term, we will be focusing on the concept of Athletics. We will be exploring a number of different activities to enable all children to access Sports Day.

### Music

In Music we will be learning to accompany rhymes or songs with a pulse. We will be looking at the composer Mozart.

### Religious Education

During Summer Term we will be looking at the Jewish faith. Focusing on religious celebrations and answering the question "Are symbols better than words at expressing religious beliefs?"

### DT

In DT this term, we will be exploring mechanisms where they will be looking at wheels and axels to create a moving vehicle.

### Art

In Art we are learning about an artist named Andy Warhol. We will be focusing on learning warm and cold colours and producing a print on fabric.

### Geography

In Geography we are learning about the similarities and differences between Cape Town and Plymouth. The children will make contact with other children in South Africa through our school links and have an understanding of the physical and human features across the two localities.

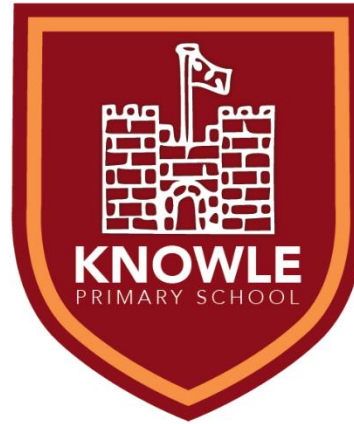
### Computing
